

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

12-19-97

THE GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT 9:00 A.M. IN THE MARION CITY BUILDING ON DECEMBER 19, 1997. THOSE IN ATTENDANCE WERE WALTER WOOD, RICHARD PUCKETT, JACQUELYN DODYK, DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION, JENNIFER OSTERHOLT, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MARION HOUSING AUTHORITY AND VALISHA CRAGUN, GRANT DEPUTY REPRESENTING THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE.

MRS. DODYK PRESENTED AN UPDATE TO THE COMMISSIONERS ON THE COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF DRUG FREE COMMUNITY FUND MONEY. SHE ALSO WANTED THE COMMISSIONERS TO BE AWARE THAT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN WILL BE SENT TO THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION.

MRS. DODYK ALSO ASKED THE COMMISSIONERS TO APPROVE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR \$360,154. THIS GRANT WILL BE USED FOR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE COSTS FOR NEW RENTAL UNITS TO BE BUILT IN 9 TO 12 MONTHS AT THE OLD THOMAS JEFFERSON SCHOOL SITE.

MR. WOOD MOVED TO SIGN THE RESOLUTION FOR SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION AT A LATER DATE, AFTER WORDING WAS CHANGED. MR. PUCKETT SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. WOOD MOVED TO HAVE CARPETS AT THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE CLEANED BY TRI-STEAMERS FROM MARION FOR \$1,485.30 DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON, WHEN THE COURTHOUSE IS CLOSED. MR. PUCKETT SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED.
